

Prayer of the Blessing of Ephraim

“His majesty is like a firstborn bull, and his horns are the horns of the wild ox; with them he shall push the peoples to the ends of the earth; they are the ten thousands of Ephraim, and they are the thousands of Manasseh.” — Deuteronomy 33:17

Father, in the name of Jesus, I come before You, God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to receive the blessing spoken over the tribe of Ephraim. Through Christ, I am grafted into the covenant promises of Israel (Romans 11:17–24), and all Your promises are “Yes and Amen” in Him (2 Corinthians 1:20).

You declared Ephraim to be mighty, fruitful, and expansive. You compared him to a firstborn bull, strong and advancing, pushing forward with authority to the ends of the earth. I receive this blessing of strength, influence, and multiplication. Let what You have placed within me grow beyond limitation and bless many.

Ephraim’s name means fruitfulness. Make me fruitful in character, calling, wisdom, and obedience. Let my life reflect increase that comes from abiding in You, not striving. Teach me to steward growth with humility and to walk faithfully in the assignments You entrust to me.

You entrusted Ephraim with leadership among the tribes. Grant me discernment to lead with integrity, courage to take responsibility, and wisdom to guide others in truth. Let influence never draw me away from You, but always deeper into dependence upon You.

Moses blessed Joseph and his sons with the precious things of heaven above and the deep beneath (Deuteronomy 33:13–16). Let these blessings rest upon me—heavenly wisdom, provision in every season, and strength drawn from Your presence.



Prayer of Repentance and Alignment

Search me, O God, and know my heart (Psalm 139:23–24). Reveal any pride, self-reliance, or misuse of influence. Forgive me for trusting in fruitfulness more than faithfulness, or in success more than obedience.

I repent of comparison, ambition apart from Your will, or forgetting the Source of blessing. Restore humility in me, that growth would always remain anchored in devotion to You.

Bind my life to Your purposes, Lord. Let fruitfulness flow from obedience and influence be governed by reverence for You. I receive Ephraim's inheritance: fruitfulness that multiplies, strength that advances, leadership that serves, and increase aligned with Your will.

May my household walk in this same blessing—fruitful, faithful, and firmly rooted in covenant truth. Blessed are You, Lord God of Israel, who brings growth from obedience and fills the earth with Your glory.
